## **Keep Child With These Symptoms** Of COVID-19 At Home:

#### **ONE Of The Following:**

- Fever (100.4°F or higher)
- New or worsened cough
- · Loss of taste or smell
- Sore throat
- New or worsened nasal congestion or runny nose

#### OR

#### TWO Of The Following:

- Headache
- Body Ache
- New or worsened fatique
- Nausea, vomiting, or diarrhea

Obtain **COVID-19 Test** 



# **Keep Child At Home Until The Following Criteria Is Met:**

#### **Positive Or Clinical Diagnosis**

Child must be cleared by the local public health department

## **Pending Test Results**

Until results are known

#### **Negative Diagnosis**

24+ hours without fever and improved symptoms

#### **Not Tested**

Ten days after symptom onset, 24+ hours without fever and improved symptoms

#### **Alternative Diagnosis**

24+ hours without fever and improved symptoms

# **Keep Child With EXPOSURE** To COVID-19 At Home:

## **Exposure Is Determined By The Local Health Department**

Close contact is defined as someone who was within six feet of a person who was either laboratory confirmed or clinically diagnosed with COVID-19 for at least 15 minutes

# **Following Criteria Is Met:**

**Keep Child At Home Until The** 

### **Obtain COVID-19 Test**

Child must be cleared by the local public health department. Refer above for more information

## **Notification Of Exposure**

The local health department will assist schools and child care centers in determining which asymptomatic children may require testing when an entire cohort, classroom or team has been exposed
